

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 11, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held August 11, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Ginger Bollinger, Tim Pietrasewicz, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the July 28, 2021, Regular Meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 12, 2021– General Fund: \$35,364.46 and State Fund: \$59,865.31. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$1,635.35. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Ginger Bollinger – Resident on Old Route 19 thanked the Supervisors for patching the road and removing the heaved sections. She asked what future improvements to Old Route 19 are scheduled. There are no other scheduled improvements, at this time.

Discussion was held on the request from the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company to use ARPA Funds to help purchase a new air compressor and tanks. Solicitor Chris Sennett is checking to see if this is an allowable expense. There will be discussion on ARPA Funds at the next EACOG meeting on September 8th at Summit Township – 3:00 p.m.

The Waterford Fair Board asked if LeBoeuf Township would be willing to mow in front of the fair grounds. Granted.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that the travel trailer on Willey Road is still in violation. A letter may need to be sent by Solicitor Chris Sennett, if the trailer isn't removed. Brian Jones has erected a fence on the property on Route 19.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for August 12, 2021. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:50 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
