

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – July 28, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held July 28, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. after the Public Hearing (minutes to follow). Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Brent & Shannon Winkler, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Supervisor Michael Whitman joined the meeting at 6:20 p.m. by phone to vote on Ordinance #1 of 2021 and setting of pay for new part-time employee. He left the meeting at 6:26 p.m.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the July 14, 2021, Regular Meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for July 29, 2021– General Fund: \$19,968.17 and State Fund: \$66,068.07. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$1,635.34. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to adopt and sign Ordinance #1 of 2021 – Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance, James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to set the wage for new part-time employee Clay Glover at \$17.00 per hour, Michael Whitman seconded. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman voted yes. James Glover abstained. Motion Carried.

Discussion was held on the request from the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company to use ARPA Funds to help purchase a new air compressor and tanks. Supervisors are considering donating up to \$20,000.00 towards the cost. Tabled.

The ECATO picnic is August 26, 2021.

Michael Porter motioned to open a new bank account at Northwest Bank for the ARPA Funds received from the Federal Government. LeBoeuf Township Supervisors who are authorized to Sign checks will be James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman and Secretary/Treasurer Catherine Wise. Each check will be required to have 2 signatures. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. The Account will be opened with the \$85,776.42 which was deposited in the LeBoeuf Township General Fund from the ARPA funds.

Road Foreman Report: Drew Francisco reported that the road crew has been performing scratch paving on Old Meadville Road and will be milling bumps on Old Route 19. Ed Musgrave will begin using a trencher on Stone Quarry Road. Clay Glover was hired for a few weeks to help with Equipment Maintenance, etc. Travis Blum performed ditching on Stone Quarry Road. Suit-Kote will be Tarring and Chipping 2 miles of roadways starting on August 20, 2021.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that a tree fell on Brian Laffan's house on Dutchtown Road. It did not do any major damage.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to sign Bills & Payroll for July 29, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:07 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
