

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 27, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held October 27, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Ginger Bollinger, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco, Dawn McLaughlin and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the minutes from the October 13, 2021, Regular Meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for October 21, 2021– General Fund: \$17,650.66 and State Fund: \$28,781.40. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$777.72. ARPA Funds: \$85,778.30. Line of Credit Account: Due-\$15,385.88, Remaining: \$84,614.81. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on updating the Small Wireless Facilities Ordinance. Michael Porter motioned to instruct Knox Law to update the ordinance to follow the new laws. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

A list of Equipment was reviewed for the 2022 Insurance Quote. Michael Porter asked of the Generator is covered in the insurance policy for replacement costs. This information will be acquired.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Recycled Asphalt Millings Sales Agreement with the City of Erie. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Road Foreman Report: Both Bridge Projects are due to start on November 2, 2021. The Equipment is being moved in and the Pipes have been delivered. Plow trucks are being readied for winter plowing. Old Route 19 will be worked on. Discussion was held on Improvements to Old Plank Road.

An application was received from Kevin Skelly for Winter snow-plow operator. Michael Porter moved to set his wage at \$18.00 per hour. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported on the Variance Hearing for Rudy Shetler – to build a sawmill – The Zoning Hearing board approved the request. Mill Run Collision will be expanding their building.

Secretary Report: The budget workshop will be held Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for October 21, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:36 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
