

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – December 8, 2021

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held December 8, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Ginger Bollinger, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the minutes from the November 24, 2021, Regular Meeting. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for December 2, 2021– General Fund: \$33,647.60 and State Fund: \$36,427.86. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$777.73. ARPA Funds: \$17,894.33. Line of Credit Account: \$100,000.00. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to sign Resolution #7 of 2021 – Small Flow System for Andrew Francisco. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisor Enactments for 2022 Taxes were tabled.

Road Foreman Report: Plowing and Cindering when needed. Kevin Skelly has opted not to snowplow for LeBoeuf Township. Discussion was held on purchasing a Roller in 2022. An extension has been granted for the McGahen Hill Road Bridge Project until June 30, 2022. Discussion was also held on the 2022 Tar & Chip Projects. Tabled. The Church Road Project – placement of rip-rap within the ditches - has been completed

Michael Porter motioned to open a Capital Reserve (Savings) Account at Northwest Bank. Signers on the account will be Supervisors: James Glover, Michael Whitman, Michael Porter and Secretary/Treasurer Catherine Wise. The account will be opened with \$1,000.00 from the LeBoeuf Township General Fund Account. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to ratify Bills & Payroll for December 2, 2021. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
