

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 13, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held April 13, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Ginger Bollinger Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the March 23,2022 Regular Meeting minutes. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for April 7, 2022– General Fund: \$44,904.69 and State Fund: \$154,753.65. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6355.68. ARPA Funds: \$6,054.40. Line of Credit Account: \$71,004.53 Remaining. Capital Reserve Fund: \$1500.00. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

In regard to Ordinance #1 of 2022 – Weight Limit Ordinance: The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors will hold a public hearing on April 27,2022 at 6:00 p.m. Letters will be sent to local haulers to inform them of the meeting. A list was reviewed.

Spectrum Cable sent a franchise agreement for review. Solicitor Nietupski stated that the Armstrong Franchise Agreement is non inclusive. Supervisors tabled the Spectrum agreement until further review.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that the road crew graded Willey and Moore Roads. An Excavator was rented for 2 weeks for ditching. The 672 Grader has been repaired and is ready to use. The tar & chip bid results will be available at the next meeting. Discussion was held on various roads to receive tar & chip this year, suggested sections were: Stone Quarry Road from the Bridge East to Vincent Road. A section of Old Meadville Road and possibly Moore Road or Willey Road. Letters will be sent to residents on Dutchtown Road requesting the replacement of their driveway pipes.

Secretary Report: The Spring Newsletter was reviewed again. Security cameras were discussed. Google Nest. Prices were acquired. Additional costs for product will be looked into.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that an additional letter was sent to the Rainbow Farm and it has been cleaned up. It was advised to have Solicitor Nietupski to send clean up letters to 2 properties on McGahen Hill Road.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Michael Porter motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for April 7, 2022. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:16 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
