

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 11, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 11, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Michael Whitman, Ginger Bollinger, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Ralph Hunter was present from 8:05-8:15 am.

James Glover motioned to approve the April 26, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes and Public Hearing Minutes. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 5, 2022– General Fund: \$32,819.16 and State Fund: \$137,170.37. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,355.75. ARPA Funds: \$6,054.66. Line of Credit Account: \$76,004.53 Remaining. Capital Reserve Fund: \$1500.01. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

In regard to the Spectrum Cable franchise agreement: Solicitor Nietupski stated that language in the agreement will need to be revised before the Supervisors can sign the agreement. Tabled.
The Weight Limit Ordinance has been tabled until a discussion can be held with the PA State Police.

Gravel Crushing – Ralph Hunter was present to state his quoted bid of \$6.62 per yard can be used for a reduced amount of crushing – Supervisors are revising their quantity to approximately 3,000 yards of finished product by July 31, 2022 (Crushed and Screened, 1 ½ minus gravel). Three official quotes will be acquired. Tabled.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that 75 percent of the roads have been graded. An inlet was placed on Blaine Melnick's property (an agreement will be signed to file a record of the approved construction on his property). Two miles of tar and chip placement was decided as follows: Stone Quarry Road between Willey Road and Vincent Road along with Repairs to Dutchtown and Union LeBoeuf Road are scheduled to be done this year.

Tim Pietrasewicz has been doing some maintenance on the municipal building: The roof needs re-sealed and the gutters need fixed. A cost was presented for roof sealer. Tim Pietrasewicz is willing to perform the sealing of the roof.

Secretary Report: Clean up day was discussed. Water, Ice, Donuts, Chips and Pizza will be provided for workers and volunteers.

The EACOG zoom meeting was reviewed. Available Grants were presented.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz presented 1 permit.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for May 5, 2022. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
