

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 25, 2022**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held May 25, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Michael Whitman, Steve & Ginger Bollinger, Dan Hanas, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise. Bruce Wise arrived at 6:17 pm.

James Glover motioned to approve the May 11 ,2022 Regular Meeting minutes. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 19, 2022– General Fund: \$80,278.09 and State Fund: \$131,637.65. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,356.01. ARPA Funds: \$6,054.91. Line of Credit Account: \$100,000.00 Remaining. Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.02. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Dan Hanas would like a Recreational Vehicle Permit. A port a potty is not affordable. He would like to use a sanitation company to pump his tanks out (Sewage & Grey Water). Supervisors stated that he should get a letter from the company stating that they will be performing the service of pumping his tanks and turn in receipts to the township showing when the tanks are emptied. Dan Hanas left at 6:15 p.m.

Trucking Bids: 2 bids were received. NicDit Trucking/Empire bid \$125.00 per hour; Cindy Glover Trucking bid \$115.00 per hour. Michael Porter motioned to accept the bid from Cindy Glover Trucking. Michael Whitman seconded. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman voted yes. James Glover abstained. Motion carried.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that Union LeBoeuf Road large potholes were fixed. First Gradings have been completed on LeBoeuf Township Roads. McGahen Hill Road will be closed starting May 31,2022 for the Month of June to finish the new bridge.

Conneauttee Road has been measured for the Conservation District Grant Project. The Mower Tractor needs extensive repairs the Hydraulic Pump and Power Steering need fixed. Supervisors suggested getting a repair estimate from Steiner's and to inquire if Washington Township would be willing to trade mowing for trucking or some other service. Discussion was held on how to fix Union LeBoeuf Road. Bruce Wise gave his opinion on Reclamation, Base Repair and Drainage. Donegal, Mt. Carmel, Lindy Paving, etc. will be called for quotes.

Crushing of Millings and Gravel were discussed. Dwyer will be hired to crush and screen millings.

Supervisor Michael Whitman stated that White Oak Drive and Dutchtown Road needs fixed graded.

Zoning: One permit was reviewed. Supervisors stated that the May Farm on McGahen Hill road did not have a written formal complaint, so LeBoeuf Township will not enforce the clean-up of the property at this time. Supervisors approved a new clean-up letter to Brian Laffan on Dutchtown Road concerning grass, structure, and junk cars.

Costs for Building cameras from Google were reviewed. More information will be acquired from Blink.

Armstrong Cable has started installing cable lines on Stone Quarry Road and Flatts Road.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Michael Porter motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for May 19, 2022. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman, to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:11 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
