

## **LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – June 22, 2022**

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held June 22, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Michael Porter, James Glover, Michael Whitman, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the June 8, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for June 16, 2022– General Fund: \$110,311.88 and State Fund: \$117,554.81. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,356.28. ARPA Funds: \$6,054.91. Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.05. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that results from the core samples have not come in yet on Union LeBoeuf Road.

Enforcement of the Weight Limit Ordinance will be discussed at the July 13, 2022 meeting. Trooper Callahan and Solicitor Nietupski are slated to attend.

At present time, the Supervisors would like a quote from Steiners for repair costs for the Mower Tractor. LeBoeuf Township does not have the funds to buy a new one this year.

A Roller has been located in New York State Michael Porter and Michael Whitman approved purchasing the machinery.

The Road crew has been Grading and Brining roads. Millings were Received from McCormick Construction. Several lifts of Gravel were placed on Stone Quarry Road. The McGahen Hill Road Bridge Project should be completed by the middle of July.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz submitted permits. Residents on Old Route 19 complained about garbage on a property. A letter will be sent asking them to clean up the property.

Supervisors agreed to donate \$250.00 to the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company for services rendered on Clean-Up Day.

Correspondence and Permits were read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for June 16, 2022. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:46 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
