

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 10, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held August 10, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 8:02 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Drew Francisco, and Catherine Wise. Guests: Ginger Bollinger,

Michael Porter motioned to approve the July 27, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 11, 2022– General Fund: \$44,267.49 and State Fund: \$56,493.43. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$5,866.55, ARPA Funds: \$6,055.42, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.09. Line of Credit: \$100,000.00 remaining. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Supervisors are interviewing potential employees. Seven applications have been received. The Supervisors will be holding interviews within the next week.

Discussion was held on switching Electric Providers. Supervisor Porter stated that if a substantial rate reduction is submitted with a 5-year agreement to keep price at the reduction, then they will consider switching.

Supervisor spoke by phone at 9:03 a.m. with Solicitor Gery Nietupski concerning the Weight Limit Ordinance. They requested an amendment be made – inserting that Agriculture and Agricultural Businesses will be exempt. Tabled.

Solicitor Gery Nietupski submitted a draft of the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company Insurance Billing Ordinance. Supervisors agreed that they will use the proposed ordinance. A Public Hearing will be scheduled in September.

Discussion was held on improvements to Union LeBoeuf Road. Supervisors would like to install parallel drains, and tailgate millings to seal the road. Dutchtown Road will require 1 parallel drain and 2 loads of asphalt to seal damaged roadway. Washington Township will place the asphalt on Dutchtown Road.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that the mower has been fixed. Gravel was spread on the backside of Church Road and the roadway was graded. The new roller has been delivered. Suite-Kote will be spreading tar and chip on Old Meadville and Stone Quarry Roads within the week. Discussion was held on the Brine Invoice. The Brine was quoted at \$0.26 a gallon, but there may have been a miscommunication on the price. The price should be \$0.28 per gallon as per Randy Brace. Tabled.

Correspondence was read & reviewed. Three permits were received.

Supervisor Michael Porter requested a Building Requirement list/Permitting List be developed. Supervisor Porter also requested a list of Employee Requirements/Responsibilities; Other Townships within Erie County will be asked for their employee requirements list/handbook.

James Glover motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for August 11, 2022. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by James Glover to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:20 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
