

## LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 24, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held August 24, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco, Tim Pie and Catherine Wise. Guests: Ginger Bollinger, Ed Falconer and Rodney Morris.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the August 10, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 25, 2022– General Fund: \$69,607.80 and State Fund: \$50,601.74. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$5,866.82, ARPA Funds: \$6,326.88, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.13. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to adopt and sign *Ordinance #1 of 2022 – The Weight Limit Ordinance*, Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes. Motion Carried.

Supervisors were invited to the 811 Safety Days.

Garbage Pick-up was discussed. B.W. Stroup will be contacted first.

Employee Chris Truitt may be able to work "light duty" starting September 6, 2022, dependent on a written release from his doctor.

The Supervisors hired Rodney Morris, who will begin on September 6, 2022. He will have a 90-day probation period. Starting wage is \$19.00 per hour. A MVR and a Drug/Alcohol test will be acquired before he begins. He is in the process of applying for an addition of Air Brakes to his CDL license. His Health Reimbursement Account will be pro-rated, and he will meet with a Cintas Representative for his clothing order. He will be added to the Drivers list for Insurance purposes and his Pension information will be forwarded to PMRS.

Road Foreman Drew Francisco reported that he is receiving paving quotes/estimates for a ~~6ft x 20ft section of~~ Total Area of 1,032 Square Yards on Dutchtown Road, approximately 170 tons. The McGahen Hill Road Bridge has been completed all invoices and bonuses have been paid. The 2022 Conneauttee Road Grant Project will begin the second week of September. Work on Union LeBoeuf Road tiling and cross-pipes will begin after the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

Zoning Officer Tim Pie submitted 2 permits. Port Farms will be having Fireworks on September 17, 2022 - The Fireworks company submitted information and the MVVFC has been notified. The Property at the corner of Route 6 and Route 19 has been sold. The old building will be used as a training site for the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company who will be burning it down. Construction of multiple AirB&B's is being proposed.

Public Comment: Ed Falconer notified the Supervisors that Mill Village Borough Council passed a Billing Ordinance for the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company. He also stated that Mill Village Borough is interested in bidding tar & chip jointly with LeBoeuf Township in 2023. The Mill Village Borough Council would like to tar & chip a section of Depot Street.

Michael Whitman motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for August 25, 2022. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by James Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 7:11 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
