LeBoeuf Township received multiple grants in the past 5 years.

Union LeBoeuf & Old Meadville Road both previously received grants through the Dirt & Gravel Road Program which is run by the Erie County Conservation District.

Mystic Road Bridge was funded through the Act 13 At-Risk Bridge Program- Administered through the Erie County Department of Planning & Community Development.

McGahen Hill Road Bridge was funded through Both the Act 13 At-Risk Bridge Program & the Erie County Conservation District.

2022 Conneauttee Road Project was funded through the Dirt & Gravel Road Program.

These Grants enabled the township to Improve the roadways at reduced costs to taxpayers.
