

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 12, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held October 12, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the September 28, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for October 6, 2022– General Fund: \$59,320.94, State Fund: \$34,072.27. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,228.12, ARPA Funds: \$92,374.76, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.17, Line of Credit: \$32,020.49 remaining. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

McGahan Hill Road will receive an inspection this month.

Supervisors do not want to shop for insurance this year. The current insurance company is doing a good job.

Kicker Disposal has been hired to pick up the garbage from the Township building.

The Union LeBoeuf Road Bridge received an inspection. A new sign was added warning of bridge in ¼ mile and the trees were removed from the base of the bridge.

The Fall/Winter Newsletter was reviewed.

Road Foreman Report: Conneauttee Road Grant Project is almost complete. The Road crew has started "Fall Grading" and will continue when the weather is agreeable. Carl Wolfrom from Holmes Road stated that people are getting flat tires. Cold patch was added to Union LeBoeuf Road. The John Deere 772 grader has a radiator leak. Porter & South Dutchtown roads need gravel and a driveway fixed to prevent water from running on to roadway.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign the Glover Subdivision; Michael Porter seconded. Michael Whitman and Michael Porter voted yes. James Glover abstained. Motion Carried.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Bengel Subdivision; James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign the Rohrer Subdivision; Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for October 6, 2022. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:42 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
