

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – November 9, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held November 9, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Ginger Bollinger, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the October 26, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes with Corrections. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for November 3, 2022– General Fund: \$32501.88, State Fund: \$23047.57. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,228.37, ARPA Funds: \$92,376.08, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.21, Line of Credit: \$42,020.49 remaining. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Supervisors agreed to cancel the November 23, 2022 meeting due to a lack of quorum available for this day.

Michael Whitman motioned to accept the quote of \$8,800.00 for repairs to Dutchtown Road – approximately 220 square yards, weather pending. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Mill Village Borough Council will be contacted to request half the funds, due to the fact it is a shared road.

Supervisors agreed to purchase 411 stone from Carmeuse to repair various roads. Cost is not to exceed \$4,400.00 and or up to \$6,000.00 with trucking included.

Michael Whitman motioned to sign the BRD Properties request to burn and demolish the old Antique Store at the corner of Route 6 and Route 19. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. DEP required a signed letter from the LeBoeuf Township Supervisors.

Road Foreman Report: Millings were placed on Old Plank Road A crown was placed on McGahen Hill Road. The road crew has been finishing up winter grading. The plow trucks are almost ready for snow plowing.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz: A logging permit was received along with 2 permits. Jordan Oberath would like to open a business on Old Frisbeetown Road. He will be sent to the Planning Commission for review.

Secretary Catherine Wise presented a letter from Solicitor Gery Nietupski with proposed changes to the Franchise Fee Ordinance. Michael Porter and Michael Whitman stated that they will agree to it.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for November 3, 2022. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by Michael Whitman to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:49 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
