

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 26, 2022

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held October 26, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Ginger Bollinger, Chris Truitt, Tim Pietrasewicz, Drew Francisco and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the October 12, 2022 Regular Meeting minutes. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for October 20, 2022– General Fund: \$46,682.37, State Fund: \$27,633.18. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,228.37, ARPA Funds: \$92,376.08, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.21, Line of Credit: \$32,020.49 remaining. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

James Glover motioned to pass Resolution #4 – To Implement Act 57 of 2022 – Property Tax Penalty Waiver Provisions Tax. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Supervisors agreed to hold a Budget workshop on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 following the regularly scheduled meeting.

Discussion was held on the fact that there is a lot of work to do on the Township Roads before winter.

Road Foreman Report: At present time the road crew is working on Willey Road and Porter Road. A section of millings were placed on Stone Quarry Road and Willey Road North by Route 6 approach. Fall grading is being done on various roads. A review of Conneauttee Road will be performed by the Erie County Conservation District and the Grant report will be submitted for payment to LeBoeuf Township for expenses. A plow frame is being fixed at Kelly Welding.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz stated that he spoke with Joe Cunningham about his septic approval on his property on Old Route 19. A mobile home was moved in on Conneauttee Road. It blocked traffic in the roadway and was temporarily became stuck in a ditch. The Zoning Officer has not issued a permit for the placement of the mobile home at this time.

Secretary Catherine Wise presented the McCormick Paving Breakfast Meeting invitation.

Robin Harrison called about the Gleba property on McGahen Hill Road. The Supervisors need a formal complaint submitted in regard to the property.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for October 20, 2022. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:46 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
