

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – February 8, 2023

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors meeting was held February 8, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Drew Francisco, Ginger Bollinger, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the January 25, 2023 Regular Meeting minutes. Michael Whitman seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for February 9, 2023– General Fund: \$55,645.13, State Fund: \$5,260.51. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$503.89, ARPA Funds: \$75,390.53, Capital Reserve Fund: \$5,000.37, Line of Credit: \$70,631.02 remaining. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Whitman motioned to appoint Chairman James Glover to sign the Insurance Quote Request Form. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign Resolution #1 – County Aid. James Glover seconded. All voted yes. Supervisor Michael Whitman signed the Lindy Credit Application.

Discussion was held on bidding Tar & Chip on the Mark Corey's County Government bid. Supervisors are planning on bidding 1 to 2 miles. Tabled.

Supervisors requested that the following people attend the next meeting to discuss Grants and Road Grant opportunities: Grant writer Lindsey Etheridge, County Liaison Rep Jeffrey Cooper, County Council Representative Charlie Bayle, State Representative Jake Banta, County Executive Brenton Davis and Solicitor Gery Nietupski.

Mark Corey will be called to review Union LeBoeuf Road to determine how to fix it.

Mill Village Councilmen Ed Falconer and Shawn McLaughlin will be asked to attend a meeting to discuss Dutchtown Road. The road will need fixed this summer.

Road Forman report: Verizon is asking for \$1,800.00 for repairs to a line on Conneauttee Road which was damaged during the 2022 Grant Project. The line was not marked properly according to the One call. A copy of the LeBoeuf Township Utility Line Ordinance and the one call will be forwarded to Verizon.

Trucking and Gravel will need to be bid. Bids will be advertised within the next month. Mark Corey will be asked about proper wording for the Gravel Bid.

The current pick-up truck will be repaired and then taken for inspection.

Grader repairs are on hold, at present time.

Zoning Officer Tim Pietrasewicz reported that the mobile home on Conneauttee Road is only 39 feet from the road - They need to move the home back, bring in a smaller home, or apply for a variance. A permit was received on Mackey Hill Road by Guy Morelli for his garage, it did meet the setback requirements.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for February 9, 2023. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:45 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
