LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 23, 2023

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's meeting was held August 23, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were James Glover, Michael Porter, Michael Whitman, Bill Phillips, Ginger Bollinger, and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the August 9, 2023, Regular Meeting minutes. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 24, 2023– General Fund: \$78,294.15. State Fund: \$47,807.85. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$6,985.36, ARPA Funds: \$75,409.22, Capital Reserve Fund: \$15,000.82. Line of Credit: \$24,868.76 remaining. Michael Whitman seconded. Motion carried.

Secretary Catherine Wise reported on the PSATS Regional Conference. An Implementable Comprehensive Plan was suggested. Tabled.

A representative from **Text My Gov** – Zach Rindle sent a proposal for a Texting service. Supervisors stated that they are not interested at this time. There is no room in the budget for this service. Supervisors reviewed the PSATS UC Group Trust Nominees, the EACOG 30th Anniversary Celebration, a Flood Plan Management Workshop, and the UPMC Hamot Public Safety Government dinner. Discussion was held on ATVs tearing up the roads.

Road Forman report: Gravel, Ditching and Mowing have been performed. Gravel was hauled for Waterford Township per the agreement to trade services. Two stop signs were replaced. Proposals for the replacement of a pipe on Dutchtown Road are being accepted. Engineer Mark Corey is working on a permit to replace the pipe. Tabled.

Suit-Kote advised placing a Fog Seal on Union LeBoeuf Road to help with stone retention. Michael Whitman motioned to pay \$6,500.00 to Suit-Kote for the Fog Seal. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

A Teams meeting was held between LeBoeuf Township and PennDOT concerning future bridge repairs/replacements on Route 97 and Route 6.

Zoning Officer: One Permit was presented.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

Michael Whitman motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for August 24, 2023. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Whitman moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:46 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
