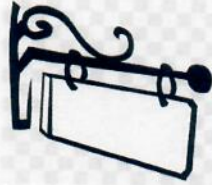
## MAILBOXES, GARBAGE CANS & VEHICLES:

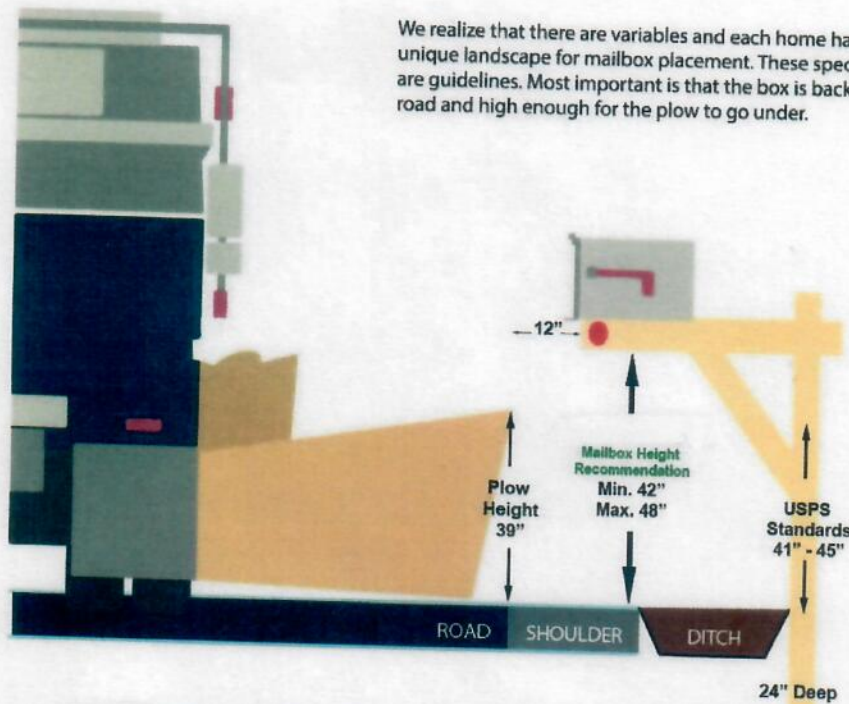

*Please Place your Garbage &  
Trash Containers OFF the  
Roadways before, during &  
after trash day pick-ups.*

We realize that there are variables and each home has a unique landscape for mailbox placement. These specifications are guidelines. Most important is that the box is back off the road and high enough for the plow to go under.



Township will only replace or repair mailboxes that have been properly setup and maintained.  
(Not one hit by snow thrown from plows.)
