

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – April 24, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on April 24, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Michael Porter, William Phillips, James Glover, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise. Guests: Matthew McAlvey & Ginger Bollinger.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the April 10, 2024, Regular Meeting minutes. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for April 18, 2024— General Fund: \$63,686.92, State Fund: \$105,611.38. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$9,204.19, ARPA Funds: \$53,430.69, Capital Reserve Fund: \$14,986.83. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Matthew McAlvey spoke with the Supervisors concerning brining of Old Meadville Road. Supervisor Michael Porter stated that due to budget constrictions most roads are only brined one time per year. This year the roads may be brined later due to the company who is hired and dependent on weather conditions. Mr. McAlvey also asked about tar & chip on Old Meadville and was informed that the roadway is on top of the list, but it will be a few years before it may be done.

Solicitor Gery Nietupski sent a response to the Question of an Amusement Tax. Tabled.

James Glover motioned to adjust the Land Bank Agreement to include "Secretary" as the contact person, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. 3 original copies were signed by Chairman James Glover.

Road Forman report: The Seal Coating is planned for August, 73 loads of millings have been hauled to the Gravel Pit from PennDOT. Cold Patching was done on various roads. Chris has been grading roads. Discussion was held on Grants: The proposed project with Waterford Township will use all the available funds for next year.

Tim reported that Heard's sells roof coating for \$68.00 per pail.

Zoning Officer: Tim stated that the Rainbow Farm has until May 4th and then he will take pictures. A report was called into the township about a toxic burning smell on Old Route 19, the landowner was notified.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

The Supervisors declined the invitation to the Pallets of Waterford.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for April 18, 2024, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by William Phillips, to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:45 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
