

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – July 10, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on July 10, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, James Glover, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise. Guests: Larry Showman and Ginger Bollinger.

William Phillips motioned to approve the June 26, 2024, Regular Meeting minutes with Corrections. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for July 11, 2024– General Fund: \$172,098.50, State Fund: \$67,391.01. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$5,792.17, ARPA Funds: \$53,437.33, Capital Reserve Fund: \$24,987.36. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Larry Showman stated that he still has a pile of #3 Stone in the Mystic Gravel Pit. He would like to know if LeBoeuf Township would like to purchase the stone, or he will have it hauled out of the pit. A per yard price will be acquired from a previous purchase by LeBoeuf Township and decided at the next meeting. Tabled.

Ginger Bollinger informed the Supervisors that there is no weight limit sign at the south bridge on Old Route 19 North. Supervisor/Road Foreman William Phillips will look into this.

Tim Pietrasewicz reported that there was a sign placed on Route 6 and Old Frisbeetown Road – it was in the right of way, he removed it and will return it to the owners, because it was causing a sight distance problem.

A letter from the Crawford County Planning Commission was reviewed concerning a new Comprehensive Plan scheduled for Crawford County.

A report was given concerning the LeBoeuf Township Planning Commission regarding the proposed Shed Ordinance and Special Event Proposed Ordinance. Tabled.

Road Forman Report: No report on Randy Brace – Vincent Road Encroachment. The Road Crew finished placing millings on aprons. Tar & Chip will begin July 15, 2024. Dodson Trucking is having trouble getting brine for roadways. Mr. Dodson stated that he may be able to get LeBoeuf Township 1 truck load every other week. A load will cover approximately 1 ½ miles. The road crew placed the Township's tank on the new trailer and is spot brining. The road crew also hauled stone for Waterford Township, as a trade for them helping with the milling project. Crushing of Millings is completed and Gravel crushing at the Mystic Road pit just started. Grading, mowing and spraying will be done in the next few weeks. A tonnage estimate of Larry Showman's #3 stone will need to be determined.

Zoning Officer: Tim submitted 3 permits.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for July 11, 2024, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by William Phillips, to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:52 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
