

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – May 8, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on May 8, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were Michael Porter, William Phillips, James Glover, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise. Guests: Charles White & Ginger Bollinger.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the April 24, 2024, Regular Meeting minutes. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 2, 2024– General Fund: \$71,289.33, State Fund: \$99,314.94. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$9,204.19, ARPA Funds: \$53,430.69, Capital Reserve Fund: \$24,986.83. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Charles White from the Rainbow Farm stated that the Vehicles have been removed and they are working on cleaning up the rest of the Junk on the Property. Supervisors stated that they have until after Clean-Up Day on May 18, 2024 to have the property finished.

Supervisors will pay for 2 firemen to attend the ECATO Annual Firemen's Dinner. No Supervisors will attend.

James Glover motioned to purchase roofing coating from Heard's at a cost up to \$2,000.00. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes. Tim Pietrasewicz stated that the roof needs a few patches before coating and Supervisors agreed to remove the old antenna from the roof. Tim Pietrasewicz will also clean out the building gutters.

William Phillips will be attending a meeting with the Engineers and Waterford Township in regard to the Multi Municipal Project.

Supervisors voted to cancel the June 12, 2024 Supervisors meeting, due to vacations.

Michael Porter motioned to purchase 2 new toilets from Trumbell Industries for the municipal building. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

William Phillips presented quotes for Excavators. Joe Cunningham has offered to sell his CAT Excavator for \$70,000.00/2-\$35,000.00 payments (250 hours on machine). John Deere Excavator – New - \$103,000.00 – 19,000 per year for 7 years or \$22,500 per year for 5 years. The CAT Excavator will be taken for a test. Tabled.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the 2024 Mill Village Borough Tar & Chip Road Agreement for Payment; William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to approve Suite-Kote quote: sealing of millings on berms of Stone Quarry Road, for an estimated cost of \$7,000.00, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Road Forman Report: Venango Township would like permission to acquire some millings from the PennDOT pile, in which LeBoeuf Township has already paid for, and will replace them at a later date this summer. Supervisors agreed to this agreement.

Millings may be hauled from Summit Township in June, these are free to LeBoeuf Township.

The road crew has been grading roads and fixing wash outs.

Supervisors discussed rollers and what will be needed for this summer's projects.

One of the Wing Walls is washing out on Stone Quarry Road, by Mr. & Mrs. Wilkins House.

Zoning Officer: Tim stated that the Municipal Building septic tank may need pumped out.
Tabled.

Discussion was held on Mr. Oberath's property. Someone may be living in a shack on the property. A letter will be sent concerning the occupation and septic approval.

A letter was sent to a resident on Union LeBoeuf Road concerning the size of a shed and that it may need a permit.

A letter needs to be sent to Mr. Tim Ploss about his property on Vincent Road. He stopped cleaning it up.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for May 2, 2024, William Phillips seconded.
All voted yes.

William Phillips moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:27 a.m.
Motion carried unanimously.
