

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – August 14, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on August 14, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise. Guest: Casey Port.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the July 24, 2024, Regular Meeting. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 8, 2024– General Fund: \$120,509.53, State Fund: \$54,476.55. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$5,792.42, Capital Reserve Fund: \$24,987.57. Line of Credit: \$50,000.00 Remaining. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on setting an amount to be voted on when using the Line of Credit. This will be addressed at the Re-Org meeting in January 2025.

The ECATO Picnic is Thursday, August 22, 2024. William Phillips, Tim Pie, Rodney Morris and Catherine Wise will attend.

The ECATO By-Laws were presented. No comments from Supervisors.

Robert Banks sent information on the Ag Preservation Application, etc. Supervisors stated that if he can acquire the acreage, then they will revisit the requirements to implement the program.

Discussion was held concerning the Employee Handbook, it was suggested to contact the Insurance Agency, to see if they require anything specific to be addressed. The Supervisors will hold a work session in the near future, to review everything that they want in the Handbook.

Tim Pietrasewicz and Rodney Morris are working on coating the roof and roof/gutter repairs. Pictures and information will be filed for future reference.

Road Forman Report: A quote will be acquired to place a Fog Seal on the newest section Stone Quarry Road that was Tarred & Chipped. Parts for the Mower Tractor were purchased for a price of \$1,000. 00. The Brine Invoice was received. Brine costs for 2024 were \$0.36 a gallon applied and \$0.20 a gallon picked up. The total cost as of this date is \$17, 232.00.

Zoning Officer: 3 permits were presented. Discussion was held on Robin Yapple's sign which charges a fee to kayakers. PennDOT was contacted about signs within the state Right of Ways - They stated that signs may not be placed within the State Right of Ways.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for August 8, 2024, Wiliam Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by William Phillips, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:03 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
