

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – September 11, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on September 11, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise.

James Glover motioned to approve the August 28, 2024, Regular Meeting Minutes. Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for September 5, 2024– General Fund: \$97,943.86, State Fund: \$40,791.24. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$5,792.42, Capital Reserve Fund: \$24,987.57. Line of Credit: \$50,000.00 Remaining. Michael Porter seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Gerald and Kelly Port Subdivision; William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

William Phillips motioned to sign Resolution #5 – the Dolan Sewage Resolution. Michael Porter seconded, all voted yes.

Discussion was held on Yearly Fees for Rental Properties and if this is something that LeBoeuf Township would like to implement. Solicitor Gery Nietupski will be asked his opinion.

The Septic Tank needs to be cleaned out. James & Son will be called.

A letter will be sent to Lee Debrakeleer asking him to please keep mowed grass off roadways.

The budget was discussed. A 3rd Quarter report will be generated for the next meeting.

Road Forman Report: Gravel was placed on Smith and Old Meadville Roads. A driveway pipe was installed on Smith Road. Ditches were cleaned on McGahen Hill Road.

Supervisors will instruct Gery Nietupski to send a letter to Mark Wilde on McGahen Hill Road, requesting that in the future he does not place debris in ditches. The Township workers cleaned it up before it rained.

Supervisors are still looking for a new Mowing Tractor or parts for the old one. Due to the cost, a fog seal will not be placed on the new tar & chip section of Stone Quarry Road. The Millings placed on the sides of the roadway, on Stone Quarry Road will be sealed next week.

Zoning Officer: Tim attended a Zoning class on September 10th. The Travel Trailer on Dutchtown has been removed. Two permits were reviewed. One was for a new house being built.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for September 5, 2024, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:10 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
