

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meeting – October 9, 2024

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Meeting was held on October 9, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise.

William Phillips motioned to approve the September 25, 2024, Regular Meeting Minutes. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for October 3, 2024– General Fund: \$61,500.31, State Fund: \$26,276.32. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$2,941.81, Capital Reserve Fund: \$24,987.78. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

James Glover motioned to approve the Supervisor's Signatures on The CRIZ letter of Approval for The Erie Zoo which was dated and signed September 30, 2024. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to purchase a 2005 Mack Truck from Waterford Township for a cost of \$15,000.00 to be paid in 2 payments: \$7,500.00 in 2024 and \$7,500.00 in 2025. William Phillips seconded the motion. All voted yes. Motion carried.

The new EAGOG director is John Bartnicki, who has resigned as the Greene Township Secretary. The ECATO Convention will be held on Thursday, October 24, 2024. William Phillips, Tim Pietrasewicz and Catherine Wise will attend.

The CINTAS Agreement was reviewed.

Supervisors voted to hold a Budget Workshop on Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. This meeting will be advertised.

A Variance Hearing for Mr. Litz will be held on October 22, 2024, to erect a sign on Route 19.

Road Forman Report: The Road Crew has been pulling shoulders and Placing Gravel on Church Road. They will be doing Conneauttee Road next.

Zoning Officer: Three permits were presented. Discussion was held on placement of Political Signs. Solicitor Gery Nietupski will be asked about permitting and fees for large political signs.

Correspondence was read and reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for October 3, 2024, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter moved, seconded by William Phillips, to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:35 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
