

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meetings – May 28, 2025

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Regular Meeting was held on May 28, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 8:01 a.m. Present were William Phillips, James Glover, Michael Porter, Tim Pietrasewicz, Jennifer Kosterman and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve Regular Meeting Minutes from May 14, 2025. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for May 29, 2025, General Fund: \$223,744.36, State Fund: \$89,596.85. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$7,174.45, Capital Reserve Fund: \$35,000.54. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on sending a Thank You letter to Erie County Council for the funds that were given for the Dutchtown Road Pipe Replacement Project.

James Glover motioned to purchase a Used Tractor Mower from Franklin Township for a cost of \$22,000.00, Michael Porter seconded the motion. All voted yes.

According to MSHA regulations a Job Johnny and a small building for paperwork will need to be located at the Mystic Pit. Costs will be acquired.

The Tax Collector needs a new Printer; it will be purchased in June.

Supervisors agreed to purchase a \$50.00 Gift Card to Walmart for Linda Oosterkamp (Pietrasewicz) for all her help on Clean Up Day.

At present time: the request by the Mill Village Volunteer Fire company is not in the budget. Supervisors will review this at a later time.

Paralegal Jennifer Kosterman spoke with the supervisors concerning non-compliances, setbacks, stormwater and lot coverage concerning the Property owned by Robin Yapple. More information will be given at the next meeting. Ms. Yapple would like to place a shed on the property. Discussion was also held on Special Events and Fees. The Planners will be asked to meet – to define Special Events.

Road Forman Report: Ditching & Grading. Woods Road is being worked on.

Zoning Officer: Clean up day went well. Tim reported that his truck broke down when he was going to deliver monitors and TVs and had to be towed.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glovert motioned to Sign Bills & Payroll for May 29, 2025, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes

William Phillips moved, seconded by James Glover, to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:36 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
