

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meetings – August 27, 2025

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Regular Meeting was held on August 27, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, Michael Porter, James Glover, Tim Pie, Gery Nietupski and Catherine Wise. (The time was changed to a morning meeting).

Michael Porter motioned to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from August 13, 2025. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for August 21, 2025, General Fund Bank Total: \$155,221.95, State Fund: \$41,678.91. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$3,032.46, Capital Reserve Fund: \$35,001.43. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

ECATO Bylaws were reviewed.

The Roller has been placed on Municibid until September 18, 2025.

Regarding the Fullerton DCOMM cable request – they are contracted through Spectrum who we have an agreement with. An Application Form for installation of cable lines will be investigated and As Builds will be requested.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors and Solicitor Gery Nietupski discussed Special Event Permits. Gery Nietupski will be attending a Planners meeting to discuss this subject with them on Tuesday, September 9, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. this will be advertised due to changing the meeting from the 2nd of September to the 9th of September. Also discussed were the following: An Amusement Tax, Road Usage, Noise, Expenses associated with Businesses within LeBoeuf Township and Solar Farms.

The LeBoeuf Township Employee Handbook was reviewed. William Phillips motioned to adopt the Employee Handbook with changes, Michael Porter seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the approval letter, appointing William Phillips to sign for all Equipment Titles & Licenses. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

Road Forman Report: The road crew placed gravel on Middleton Road. The pipe was installed on Dutchtown Road and Tiling is being done on Woods Road. Mystic Road was Graded & Brined. Stone Quarry Road will be tiled next week. Twelve loads of gravel were placed on Short Hare Road along with millings at the approaches of Short Hare & Hare Roads along Route 97.

Zoning Officer Tim Pie submitted 6 permits for review. The Hanna Property has been cleaned up. The Rainbow Farm is accumulating junk again. Discussion was held on how far you can build from a Gas Well. Engineer Mark Corey will be asked.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

Michael Porter motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for August 21, 2025, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes

James Glover moved, seconded by William Phillips to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:08 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
