

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meetings – September 10, 2025

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Regular Meeting was held on September 10, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, Michael Porter, James Glover, Tim Pie, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from August 27, 2025. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for September 4, 2025, General Fund Bank Total: \$146,902.26, State Fund: \$32,025.56. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$3,032.46, Capital Reserve Fund: \$35,001.43. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

James Glover motioned to pay \$15.00 per month to Secretary/Treasurer for Cell Phone Expenses, starting in September 2025. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Liability, Vehicle and Workman's Comp Insurance was discussed. Tabled.
Special Events was tabled.

Discussion was held on Accessory Building Permits to include pavilions, car ports, sheds, etc. A clear definition will be added to the current Zoning Ordinance with an amendment to remove the size component and make all accessory structures requiring a zoning permit. Tabled.

Road Forman Report: The road crew has been producing gravel in the pit. The screener will need a repair. Summerhill Township has looked at the roller. It is currently on Municibid. Tabled. Tiling on Woods Road and Stone Quarry Road have been completed.

Zoning Officer Tim Pie submitted one permit. Discussion was held on the property at Route 6 & Willey Road – they are tearing trailers apart and burning. There are also junk vehicles placed on property. The land owner will receive a letter from Solicitor Gery Nietupski. Calls have been received concerning Solar fields and applications.

Supervisor William Phillips reported that LeBoeuf Township will be partnering with Waterford Township for a Grant to Engineer various roads for tiling. Tabled.
The EADS Group will be asked about hiring them to apply for an LSA Grant for a new grader. Tabled.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for September 4, 2025, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes

William Phillips moved, seconded by Michael Porter to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:21 a.m. Motion carried unanimously
