

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meetings – December 10, 2025

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Regular Meeting was held on December 10, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. Present were William Phillips, Michael Porter, James Glover, Tim Pie, and Catherine Wise.

Michael Porter motioned to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from November 26, 2025. William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for December 11, 2025, General Fund Bank Total: \$139,135.24, State Fund: \$6,829.04. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$1,901.80, Capital Reserve Fund: \$35,002.32. Line of Credit Remaining: \$62,929.17. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors voted to set the Re-Org Meeting for Monday, January 5, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisors voted to cancel the December 24, 2025 regular meeting.

William Phillips motioned to Appoint the Following to the Auditor Positions for 2026 and 2027 (the next municipal election), Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to approve, the Chairman, to sign the Buseck, Barger, Bleil & Co. Audit Services Agreement, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

Road Forman Report: The Road Crew has been plowing snow and spreading anti-skid. New studs were made for the Ford Truck Axle. 3 letters were sent out to residents who had cars too close to the roadway. Bill stated that 5-Star has 6 excavators available. He is interested in purchasing 1. Tabled.

Zoning Officer Tim Pie presented 2 permits. A letter was sent out concerning a shed with no permit. Guy Morreli is working on his septic approval before he can obtain a zoning/building permit.

William Phillips motioned to approve the 2026 Budget as presented. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.
