

LeBoeuf Township Supervisors Meetings – January 28, 2026

The LeBoeuf Township Supervisor's Regular Meeting was held on January 28, 2026. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were William Phillips, Michael Porter, James Glover, Tim Pie, and Catherine Wise.

William Phillips motioned to approve the Re-Organization Meeting Minutes and Regular Meeting Minutes from January 5, 2026. James Glover seconded. All voted yes.

James Glover moved to submit for audit the Treasurer's Report for January 22, 2026, General Fund: \$92,266.23, State Fund: \$6,439.10. Health Reimbursement Fund: \$251.40, Capital Reserve Fund: \$35,002.91. Line of Credit Remaining: \$62,929.17. William Phillips seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the Hochstettler Subdivision, William Phillips seconded. All voted yes.

William Phillips motioned to Sign the County Aid Application - Resolution #1 of 2026, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

Michael Porter motioned to sign the E.L. Heard Fuel Certificates, William Phillips seconded the motion. All voted yes. Chairman James Glover signed the agreements.

Discussion was held on the Accessory Building Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance & Car Ports. Fee Schedules, Solar Hearings, Solar Fees, etc. Tabled.

Road Forman Report: The road crew has been plowing snow and spreading anti-skid. Rodney had a piece of metal fall on his head and had 4 staples put in. Workman's Comp was notified. He only missed ½ day of work. More Anti-Skid needs to be purchased.

Zoning Officer Tim Pie submitted 1 permit. Discussion was held on what to do about the parking at 6 & 19 and the property on Willey Road & Route 6 has a garage on it and it needs a permit.

Supervisors gave Solicitor Gery Nietupski the approval to take the next step with the King's wedding barn on Wheelertown Road – the magistrate will be notified.

The Supervisors requested that Gery Nietupski or Jennifer Kosterman attend a meeting to answer a few legal questions they have concerning various subjects.

Correspondence was read & reviewed.

James Glover motioned to Ratify Bills & Payroll for December 31, 2025, January 8, 2026 and January 22, 2026, Michael Porter seconded. All voted yes.

William Phillips moved, seconded by Michael Porter, to adjourn the regular meeting at 6:51 p.m. Motion carried unanimously
